Protect yourself and others from COVID-19. It is required to wear a face covering when you are within six feet of others and in common areas including:

Elevators, Stairwells, Conference Rooms, Break Rooms, Hallways, Parking Lots, Entering/Exiting Buildings, Bathrooms, and When Sharing a Vehicle with Others!

If a co-worker asks you to wear a face covering, please remember that their health is on the line, too, and be respectful. They're asking because they're concerned about everyone's health, including yours. Let's all reinforce our Culture of Caring by wearing your face covering and reminding others to do the same when required.

Face coverings reduce airborne transmission

Infectious aerosol particles can be released during breathing and speaking by asymptomatic infected individuals. No covering maximizes exposure, whereas universal covering results in the least exposure.
