U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Advisory Board to Meet

A public meeting hosted by the Nevada Site Specific Advisory Board (NSSAB) will begin at 5 p.m., Wednesday, May 18, 2016, at the Frank H. Rogers Science and Technology Building, 755 East Flamingo Road, Las Vegas, Nevada. Planned meeting topics include a briefing and recommendation development for proposed changes to long-term monitoring at closed soil sites, revegetation at a closed soil site, and recommendation development for the radioactive waste acceptance process.

Prior to the public meeting, an educational session will begin at 4 p.m. on the Motor Carrier Evaluation Program by DOE's Office of Packaging and Transportation.

The NSSAB is a federally-chartered board comprised of rural and urban southern Nevada residents who provide recommendations to the DOE Environmental Management Program regarding environmental cleanup activities at the Nevada National Security Site.
