**U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Advisory Board to Meet**

A public meeting hosted by the Nevada Site Specific Advisory Board (NSSAB) will begin at 4 p.m., Wednesday, January 18, 2017, at the Frank H. Rogers Science and Technology Building, 755 East Flamingo, Las Vegas, Nevada. The planned meeting topics include the cleanup of historic above-ground nuclear testing locations on the Nevada National Security Site (NNSA) and an explanation of the groundwater internal review process.

Prior to the public meeting, an educational session will begin at 3 p.m. on compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act at the NNSA by Carrie Stewart, National Nuclear Security Administration Nevada Field Office.

The NSSAB is a federally-chartered board comprised of rural and urban southern Nevada residents who provide recommendations to the DOE Environmental Management Program regarding environmental cleanup activities at the NNSA.
