

Housing Information - FAQ

Q: How do I make housing arrangements?

A: All students are personally responsible for locating housing. We offer a few listings here. When called about a job offer, ask whether other students are looking to share housing.

Q: What towns/cities are nearby Las Vegas for housing?

A: Generally Las Vegas city/suburb housing is within 10 to 45 minutes of our 2 North Las Vegas locations and about 60 to 90 minutes to the Nevada National Security Site (NNSS). Where you choose to live may be affected by commute time, housing costs and transportation availability. Some students choose to share housing.

Q: Will I receive any assistance with my monthly rental costs?

A: We do not provide any financial assistance for the cost of housing during the summer term. However, relocation allowances are provided for transportation and in-route lodging (if over 100 miles from work) in preparation for the summer term. We highly recommend confirming housing arrangements prior to traveling.

Mercury Dorms

For those students working at the NNSS near Mercury, NV this is the only option within 40-50 minutes,

- Cost: \$40 per night or \$175 weekly rate
- Amenities: Cable TV, Wi-Fi and fitness gym, cafeteria (pay-per-meal. Note, cafeteria not open Sat-Sun)
- Availability of 50 rooms
