The Office of Financial Management is issuing a certification, and a contract modification will be issued to deobligate available unearned fee in the amount of \$1,769,881.00 from the contract. The disposition of these funds will be determined considering the National Nuclear Security Administration enterprise-wide critical needs and the Budget and Reporting composition associated with the fiscal year 2016 unearned fee on the above referenced contract.

In cases where unearned fee is allocated to a construction project, the unearned fee will remain on the construction project and will be returned to project contingency. The project contingency cannot be moved without express approval of the Contracting Officer and the Federal Project Director or the Project Management Executive. Any future funding requests will take into account the remaining contingency on hand. Upon project completion, performance will be reevaluated, and adjustments may be made to prior fee determinations as appropriate. Also, upon project completion and financial closeout, all remaining funding including unearned fee will be deobligated, and used to address other mission needs. If the project has spent some of this funding without approval, it will be considered an unallowable cost, and a request that it be returned will be initiated.

The disposition/expenditure of Department of Energy unearned fee should be coordinated with the appropriate offices.
