U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Advisory Board to Meet

A radioactive waste transportation educational workshop hosted by the Nevada Site Specific Advisory Board (NSSAB) will begin at 4 p.m., Wednesday, July 15, 2015, at the Bob Ruud Community Center, 150 North Highway 160, Pahrump, Nevada. Topics include radiation basics, transportation packaging, routing, and information on what type of emergency response training has taken place in Nevada. Additionally, a presentation will be given by Nye County officials regarding their perspective on low-level radioactive waste transportation to the Nevada National Security Site (NNSS).

The NSSAB is a federally-chartered board comprised of rural and urban southern Nevada residents who provide recommendations to the DOE Environmental Management Program regarding environmental cleanup activities at the NNSS.
