### **U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Advisory Board to Meet**

A public meeting hosted by the Nevada Site Specific Advisory Board (NSSAB) will begin at 5 p.m., Wednesday, July 20, 2016, at the Tonopah Convention Center, 301 Brougher Avenue, Tonopah, Nevada. Planned meeting topics include air monitoring stations at historic nuclear testing locations on the Tonopah Test Range and low-level radioactive waste transportation.

Prior to the public meeting, an educational session focused on groundwater and presented by Desert Research Institute staff will begin at 4 p.m.

The NSSAB is a federally-chartered board comprised of rural and urban southern Nevada residents who provide recommendations to the DOE Environmental Management Program regarding environmental cleanup activities at the Nevada National Security Site.
