U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Advisory Board to Meet

A public meeting hosted by the Nevada Site Specific Advisory Board (NSSAB) will begin at 4 p.m., Wednesday, November 9, 2016, at the Clark County Government Center, 500 S. Grand Central Parkway, Las Vegas, Nevada. The planned meeting topic includes the cleanup of historic above-ground nuclear testing locations on the Tonopah Test Range.

Prior to the public meeting, an educational session will begin at 3 p.m., on Fundamental Principles of Radiation by Kathryn Gladden, Radiation Protection Programs Subject Matter Expert for the National Nuclear Security Administration Nevada Field Office.

The NSSAB is a federally-chartered board comprised of rural and urban southern Nevada residents who provide recommendations to the DOE Environmental Management Program regarding environmental cleanup activities at the Nevada National Security Site.
