NSTec President Holt Appointed to LVGEA Board

LAS VEGAS – Jim Holt, president of National Security Technologies LLC (NSTec), has been named to the Board of Directors of the Las Vegas Global Economic Alliance (LVGEA), the leading economic development organization in southern Nevada.



NSTec is the managing and operating contractor for the Nevada National Security Site (NNSS), under the auspices of the U.S. Department of Energy’s National Nuclear Security Administration.

“We want to represent the mix of industry that we have here in southern Nevada,” said Jonas Peterson, president of the LVGEA. Holt’s appointment, along with Michael Cunningham, executive vice president and regional president of Bank of Nevada, is a step toward that goal, he said.

Holt was appointed president of NSTec in December 2015. He presides over the company’s work at the NNSS which includes national security experiments, tests and technology demonstrations, as well as homeland security, emergency response and environmental management programs.

A private organization, the LVGEA works as a clearinghouse for economic development in southern Nevada and works directly with the Governor’s Office of Economic Development.
