**U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Advisory Board to Meet**

A public meeting hosted by the Nevada Site Specific Advisory Board (NSSAB) will begin at 4 p.m., Wednesday, August 16, 2017, at the Bob Ruud Community Center, 150 N. Highway 160, Pahrump, Nevada. The planned meeting topics include a briefing and recommendation development for proposed changes to long-term monitoring at closed soil and industrial sites and recommendation development for groundwater communication activities for the Nevada National Security Site (NNSS).

Prior to the public meeting, an educational session will begin at 3 p.m. on *Subsurface Microbial Worlds of the NNSS and the Death Valley Flow System* by Duane Moser, Desert Research Institute.

The NSSAB is a federally-chartered board comprised of rural and urban southern Nevada residents who provide recommendations to the DOE Environmental Management Nevada Program regarding environmental cleanup activities at the NNSS.
