**U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Advisory Board to Meet**

A public meeting hosted by the Nevada Site Specific Advisory Board (NSSAB) will begin at 4 p.m., Wednesday, May 16, 2018, at the Frank H. Rogers Science and Technology Building, 755 East Flamingo, Las Vegas, Nevada. The meeting will focus on the Board recommending the location of a new monitoring well at the Radioactive Waste Management Complex on the Nevada National Security Site (NNSS).

The NSSAB is a federally-chartered board comprised of rural and urban southern Nevada residents who provide recommendations to the DOE Environmental Management Nevada Program regarding environmental cleanup activities at the NNSS.
