U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Advisory Board to Meet

A public meeting hosted by the Nevada Site Specific Advisory Board (NSSAB) will begin at 4 p.m., Wednesday, January 16, 2019, at the Valley Conference Center, Valley Electric Association, 800 E. Highway 372, Pahrump, Nevada. Meeting topics include the onsite inspection of radioactive waste at generator sites and the scheduling of audits that review the waste programs of generators shipping to the Nevada National Security Site (NNSS). An overview will also be given on the steps to become an NNSS generator and the follow-up conducted to ensure that all requirements are implemented.

The NSSAB is a federally-chartered board comprised of rural and urban southern Nevada and bordering Shoshone, California residents who provide recommendations to the DOE Environmental Management Nevada Program regarding environmental cleanup activities at the NNSS. Topics regarding Yucca Mountain and national security are not within the purview of the NSSAB and will not be addressed during the meeting.
