U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Advisory Board to Meet

A public meeting hosted by the Nevada Site Specific Advisory Board (NSSAB) will begin at 4 p.m., Wednesday, November 13, 2019, at the Frank H. Rogers Science and Technology Building, 755 East Flamingo Road, Las Vegas, Nevada. Meeting topics include briefings and development of recommendations on the path forward for a historic test complex and the long-term groundwater monitoring network on the Nevada National Security Site (NNSS). The meeting will also include an educational briefing explaining the risks of tritium exposure in groundwater.

The NSSAB is a federally-chartered board comprised of rural and urban southern Nevada and bordering Shoshone, California residents who provide recommendations to the DOE Environmental Management Nevada Program regarding environmental cleanup activities at the NNSS. Topics regarding Yucca Mountain and national security are not within the purview of the NSSAB and will not be addressed during the meeting.
