**U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Advisory Board to Meet**

A public meeting hosted by the Nevada Site Specific Advisory Board (NSSAB) will begin at 4 p.m., Wednesday, January 15, 2020, at the Valley Conference Center, Valley Electric Association, 800 East Highway 372, Pahrump, Nevada 89048. Meeting topics include a briefing on existing and potential waste verification strategies and an update on the audit determination process. The meeting will also include an educational briefing explaining the waste classification systems for DOE and the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

The NSSAB is a federally-chartered board comprised of rural and urban southern Nevada and bordering Shoshone, California residents who provide recommendations to the DOE Environmental Management Nevada Program regarding environmental cleanup activities at the Nevada National Security Site. Topics regarding Yucca Mountain and national security are not within the purview of the NSSAB and will not be addressed during the meeting.
